Ġgantija Temples Historic Site

Considered one of the oldest manmade structures in the world, the two temples of Ggantija date to 3600 B.C., pre-dating the Great Pyramids of Egypt.

Basilica of Ta' Pinu

Church

This Roman Catholic basilica and shrine was completed in 1931 on the site of a small chapel dating to at least the 16th century.

Ta' Kola Windmill History Museum

Built in 1725 during the reign of the Knights of St. John, the small exhibit space showcases how the mill was once used to grind flour for local farmers.

Gordan Lighthouse (Ta' Gurdan ... Lighthouse

The lighthouse was constructed in 1851 with 21 oil lamps clearing the way for increasing maritime activity. On a clear day, you can see all the way to Sicily.

Cittadella (Iċ-Ċittadella)

A fortified castle that served as a refuge for Gozo's population in medieval times. Begin exploring this complex at the Citadel Visitors Center.
